

**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE STATE LEVEL COMPETITION FOR CELEBRATING THE
75TH ANNIVERSARY OF NETAJI'S GREAT ESCAPE (Annexure: 1)**

GENERAL GUIDELINE:

- Name of First and Second position holders at the district level in each event should be sent for the State Level Competition.
- In debate competition two candidates will be selected for the State Level Competition in the way of (a) one for the motion and (b) one against the motion.
- Participating Colleges have to send the names of the student participants in a format attached herewith.
- Candidates are to bring their original college identity card/ photocopy of college fee book duly signed by the Principal/ OIC/TIC and a photocopy of University Registration Certificate (College Fee Book in case of 1st year students) which will also be attested by the Nodal Officer.
- Judges decision will be considered as final.
- There should be no entry fees for participating at the competitions.
- Only students studying in the under graduate level are entitled to participate.

Special Instructions:

- **Candidates must carry their own ID card and all other documents in original and also photocopies of the same.**
- **One (1) candidate can participate in two (2) events only.**

**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE STATE LEVEL COMPETITION FOR CELEBRATING THE
75TH ANNIVERSARY OF NETAJI'S GREAT ESCAPE (Annexure: 2)**

ESSAY WRITING

- Essay writing competition will be held on the topic entitled "**Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose and national unity (English), Netaji Subhash Chandra Basu o jatiyo oikyo (Bengali).**"
- At the district level competition total number of words is fixed to 1500.
- At the state level competition total number of words is fixed to 3000.
- Only blue colour ball pen will be used.
- Both sides of the pages are not to be used for writing essays.
- Papers will be supplied by the organising committee.
- In the first page of the paper **Name of the Candidate, District, Name of the College, University Registration No., College Roll No.** must be mentioned.
- Clip boards may be used by the competitors. Clip boards will not be supplied by the organisers.

- Judges will be selected as per languages (**2 Judges will be there for each language**).
 - One and half hour (1 ½) time will be allowed for writing the essay at the district level and two (2) hours at the state level competition.
 - **Competition is held on seven languages, namely, Bengali, English, Hindi, Nepali, Urdu, Santhali and Sanskrit.**
 - **For seven (7) languages minimum three (3) participants must be there in each language group and 1st 2nd winner will be announced from them. If one candidate is there in one language group then the candidate will be nominated for the state level competition. Minimum screening will be done by the Judges.**

DEBATE COMPETITION

- Motion of Debate competition will be held on the topic entitled "**Netaji and Gandhiji: No major differences (English), Netaji o Gandhiji: Birat kono motantor nei (Bengali)**".
 - Name of two candidates (One for the motion and one against the motion) will be sent for the State Level Competition.
 - Total five (5) minutes will be allowed to each candidate during competition. Sequence of competition will be one for the motion and followed by one against the motion alternatively.
 - First competitor will get another one chance at the end of deliberation of lectures of all candidates for another five minutes.
 - Average of three judges will be considered for preparation of rank.

POSTER DRAWING COMPETITION

- Theme of the drawing competition will be held on the topic mentioned in **Annexure: 7**.
 - Only colour painting will be allowed.
 - Candidates are to bring colours, clip boards, palates and necessary equipments of their own. Competitors may use any medium except wood pencil (**water, oil, mix medium may be used**).
 - Organising committee will provide papers for the competition.
 - Only 14"X 11" Cartridge paper will be supplied to the competitors.
 - Total one (1) hour time will be allowed for competition.

DECLAMATION COMPETITION

- Topic of the declamation will be selected by the organisers and those will be distributed to the each competitor just five (5) minutes before his/her own competition. The topic will be selected by lottery method.
- Theme of the Declamation competition will be held on the topic mentioned in **Annexure- 7" (Freedom is given to the college and the topic has to select from the given list).**
- Four (4) minutes will be allowed for the deliberation of lecture.
- During competition keeping any written paper in the hand will not be permitted.

QUIZ COMPETITION

- Competition will be held in five (5) rounds. Area of questions will be on Netaji's life, Philosophy, India's Freedom Movement, Netaji's Great Escape, Freedom Fighters of India, Foreign contribution for independence, etc.
- Oral question, visual and audio medium must be used. (Three (3) oral question rounds and two (2) audio-visual rounds among which one (1) audio and one (1) video round must be incorporated).
- Two (2) members per team and two (2) teams per college are allowed.
