

Events organized in collaboration with Calcutta Ekatma during 2021-22

1. A 75-days skill development course was organized in collaboration with Calcutta Ekatma for the students and some members of the staff from 1.1.2021 to 17.03.2021. This course in **Handicrafts and Carpets (Traditional hand Embroiderers)** was conducted by **Jana Shikshan Sansthan (JSS), Narendrapur, West Bengal**. The certificates for the same were handed out by Prof. Bela Bose, President, Calcutta Ekatma, to the participants on 09.08.2021. Respected Prof Bela Bose, President, Calcutta Ekatma handed over the certificates. This course helped students develop their skill with regard to embroidery and enabled them to use this skill for vocational purposes.
