Inclusiveness

The College aims towards promoting an inclusive and healthy environment leading to the overall development of the students. The Administration including the Principal, all the teachers and the non-Teaching staff take special care to ensure that differently abled students, students belonging to economically weaker sections, socially marginalized sections feel comfortable and the sense of equity beyond gender, caste and class prevails on campus.

The College takes care in helping out its differently abled students, while filling forms, sitting for examinations and also attending regular classes. They are often given remedial coaching, provided financial concessions and separate examination arrangements are provided to the concerned student whenever the need arises. The Principal of the college has also duly forwarded letters for further financial help from the concerned higher authority.

The College also conducts workshops on Gender sensitization to spread awareness among students. Recently Deshbandhu College for Girls organized a workshop on Gender Equity in collaboration with Shyamaprasad College on 24/08/2022 as part of its Gender sensitization and awareness initiative.
